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




Medical Examination and Document Verification :

Candidates who successfully clear the AISSEE are invited for medical examination and document verification. The medical examination is held in the Banas General Hospital. Please ensure all documents and Affidavits are prepared when you arrive.

Financial Aspects :

Banas Sainik School aims to make quality education accessible. The fees are very affordable, that Rs. 1,38,400 per annum. Additionally, scholarships and financial aid may be available to deserving candidates based on Society policy.

Joining Instructions for Admission :

Joining instructions are issued only to boys and girls who are finally selected for admission to the School. The joining instructions contain the following documents which are required to be completed / to be submitted at the time of admission.

- (a) Income Certificate
- (b) Agreement Bond
- (c) Parent's Address Form
- (d) Study Certificate and Transfer Certificate from the previous School.
- (e) Domicile Certificate, Birth Certificate, Caste Certificate.

Students also have access to various extracurricular activities such as sports, NCC (National Cadet Corps), Personality Development and more.

ACADEMICS

Sainik Schools are residential schools, affiliated to the Ministry of Defence. They aim to prepare students for entry into the National Defence Academy (NDA). The academic curriculum typically includes subjects like Mathematics, Science, English, Social Studies, and additional subjects like Computer Science and Regional languages. In addition to academics, there's a strong emphasis on physical fitness, extracurricular activities, and character development.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

In addition to academics, the School also provides facilities for development of creative faculties and skills, awareness of life around, innovative approach to problem solving etc. in an formal surrounding through organized club activities. The Club sessions are held once a week.



LABORATORIES

The School has well established laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology Mathematics, Computers and Social Science. Students are given equal exposure of theory as well as practical knowledge of the subject.



LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

Well-resourced, aesthetically designed School Library is air-conditioned, with age-appropriate furniture that creates an inviting ambience for the young readers. A dedicated story-telling corner in the Library makes it a special place for the students.



SMART CLASS ROOMS

The spacious and well-ventilated classrooms with natural light provide a conducive environment for learning. Every classroom has audio-visual facilities including live streaming of classroom teaching, a public address system, display boards and ergonomically designed age-appropriate furniture.



OBSTACLE COURSE

The School has an Obstacle Course to test and improve the students courage, physical endurance and physique.



PHYSICAL TRAINING AND CROSS COUNTRY

P.T. is compulsory and all cadets take part in regular physical training which includes cross country runs. All the instructors are experienced and have armed forces service experience.



MEDICAL FACILITIES

The school has a part time Medical Officer. Medical Officer is assisted by a qualified Nursing Assistant. Medical treatment is free except where expensive drugs and tonics are prescribed. Physical fitness is the primary aim for cadets and the prime aim of our training schedule.



VALUES EDUCATION

1. Character Education Workshops: In Banas Sainik School we organize workshops focusing on character traits like honesty, respect, empathy, and responsibility. These workshops can include discussions, role-playing exercises, and group activities to explore and reinforce these values.
2. Service Learning Projects: Banas Sainik School provides opportunity to engage students in service learning projects that allow them to apply their knowledge and skills to address real community needs. This not only fosters a sense of social responsibility but also helps students develop empathy and compassion.
3. Moral Dilemma Discussions: Banas Sainik School facilitates discussions about moral dilemmas and ethical decision-making. School presents students with scenarios and encourage them to analyze the situations, consider different perspectives, and discuss the implications of their choices.
4. Values-Based Storytelling: Use of storytelling as a tool to convey moral lessons and values. Share stories from various cultures and traditions that highlight virtues such as kindness, courage, and integrity.
5. Peer Mentoring Programs: Establishment of peer mentoring programs where older students serve as mentors to younger students, guiding them in developing positive attitudes, behaviors, and values.

6. Community Service Projects:: Bans Sainik School encourages students to participate in community service projects, such as volunteering at local shelters, or participating in environmental clean-up efforts. These experiences foster a sense of civic engagement and altruism.


STAFF
